Our patients speak freely about the Hospice and their words might surpise you.

The word hospice can conjure images of frailty, sadness and loss, but for those patients who access our services, the experience is quite different.

Though everyone that benefits from our Wellbeing service comes to us with a diagnosis of a life-limiting condition, our aim is to remind them that they are more than their condition and that life can still be wonderful.

Here at Rossendale Hospice we focus our services on caring for people within their own home when they are in greatest need and for those who are physically able, we open our doors for day patients. Currently running twice a week, we offer people a chance to come along and enjoy a relaxing day with our wonderful team. They can talk candidly with our fully trained Counsellors, utilise our complimentary therapy services, find out important information about any legal or financial help they may be entitled to if they are unable to work and their carers can learn how to help them at home.

Primarily though, our team are there to provide advice and signposting to a wide range of professionals, smiles and a reminder that they are not alone.

Time spent in our lounge chatting to other patients has proven an invaluable healing tool for many. Whilst our nurses can offer advice and care it is often the shared experience of how others deal with their own situation that can help those struggling feel more empowered.

To do so in a place full of light and laughter over a fish and chip dinner or crafting session is often the perfect prescription on difficult days.

"It's a strange feeling because you think you are actually on your own, suffering, but you're not. There are so many people in the same boat and it's great to talk to them and get their perspective about how they're feeling. It's been really good for me."



Rossendale Hospice is expanding its services by trialling a walking therapy, offering up to 6 sessions to each client, due to start in May. This will involve working with either hospice patients or people who have been bereaved.

As a hospice, our aim is to improve quality of life for our patients and there is a great deal of evidence behind the physical, mental and emotional health benefits of connecting with the natural world. Combining this with our BACP Accredited talking therapies gives our patients a relaxing environment to be able to open up and talk.

Being outdoors and with the beautiful natural resources just on our doorstep gives the opportunity to draw on the experiences of being in nature; complementing the therapy process, helping to work on setting new goals; to build resilience and a sense of belonging and wellbeing.

Each referral will be assessed on an individual basis. Levels of fitness will be taken into account prior to each session with each route individually adapted changes to planned walks.
