

Forget me not knitting pattern

Knitting Needles Size 3mm or No 11

Wool: double knitting wool (blue for petals, yellow for centre)

Petals – Blue

Make 5 petals by repeating the steps below.

Repeat rows 2-15, 3 more times, then repeat rows 2-14 again.

Cast off leaving around 7" (approx. 18cm of wool)

Cast on 6 stitches

Row 1: Knit to end of row

Row 2: Knit to end of row

Row 3: Knit 1, make 1 and knit to end of row

Row 4: Knit to end of row

Row 5: Knit 1, make 1 and knit to end of row (8 stitches)

Rows 6, 7, 8: Knit

Row 9: Knit 1, Knit 2 together through the back loop, knit to end of row

Row 10: Knit to end of row

Row 11: Knit 1, Knit 2 together through the back loop, knit to end of row

Row 12: Knit to end of row (6 stitches)

Row 13: Cast off 3 stitches, knit to end of row (3 stitches)

Row 14: Knit to end of row

Row 15: Cast on 3 stitches, knit to end of row





Middle of flower – Yellow

Cast on 3 stitches

Row 1: Knit to end of row

Row 2: Knit to end of row

Row 3: Knit 1, make 1, make 1 and knit 1 (5 stitches)

Row 4: Knit to end of row

Row 5, 6, 7, 8 : Knit

Rows 9: Knit 1, knit 2 together, knit 2 together (3 stitches)

Row 10: Knit to end of row

Row 11: Knit to end of row

Row 12: Cast off



Making up the flower

To make up the flower, take the petals and thread the wool, which you cut at 7", along the straight edge of the main part, then pull tightly and secure.

Sew the cream/yellow middle into centre, then pull tightly and secure.

Draw this up, then sew into the centre.
